Friday - Day 1 Arrive in Boston

 2:30 PM Arrive in **Boston** and meet your **local guide** who will take you on a walk through Boston's North End where you will view the Paul Revere House visit the Old North Church – where the lanterns were hung signaling “One if by Land, Two if by Sea”. Next, tour the Freedom trail where your guide will highlight sites like The Omni Parker House, site of the famous authors Saturday Club, The Boston Common, The Public Gardens, The Old and New State Houses, the 54th Regiment Statue and more.
 6:15 PM **Dinner** will be included at **Fire and Ice** in the North End.
 8:15 PM Check into your hotel North of Boston.



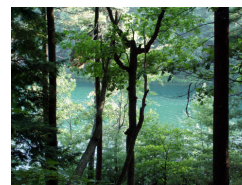
Saturday – Day 2 Salem - Ipswich

 9:00 PM Head into the bewitching seaport of Salem and enjoy a city tour as well as admission to **The House of the Seven Gables** made famous by Nathaniel Hawthorne's novel about the Salem Witch Trials.
 Lunch and shopping time on your own at Pickering Wharf in Salem.
 This afternoon you will head to beautiful historic Ipswich Massachusetts. Ipswich was the home to John Updike for many years and where his children grew up. This beautiful seaside town is typical New England.
 3:30 PM Wine tasting at **Russell Orchards** in Ipswich.
 Next head over to **Gloucester, MA** – home of the movie and novel “**The Perfect Storm**”.
 6:00 PM Lobster Bake **Dinner** included in Gloucester.
 8:00 PM Return to your hotel.



Sunday – Day 3

 9:00 AM Begin your full day tour – **Lexington Concord**.
 9:30 AM Arrive in Lexington and visit Lexington Green, following the revolutionary road to Concord. Visit the **Orchard House**, home to the Alcott Family and setting for the novel by Louisa May “Little Women”. Stop at Sleepy Hollow Cemetery - Author's Ridge, where Emerson, Thoreau, Longfellow, Hawthorne, and Margaret Sidney are all buried. Also, a stop at Walden Pond made famous by Thoreau's story of the same name.
 12:45 PM **Lunch** included at the **Colonial Inn** before departing for home.
 2:00 PM Depart for home
