Genealogy:

- **HeritageQuest** has one of the largest collections of genealogy material in the USA.

Health:

- **Health Reference Center Academic** includes over 2800 health and medical journals and magazines, many of which are full text. *

Language Instruction:

- **Mango Languages** teaches actual conversational skills for 42 languages and with 16 ESL courses.

Literature:

- **Literature Resource Center** contains author biographies & critical analysis about every genre, and literary discipline, through the centuries.**
- **Novelist (EBSCO)** is a readers advisory resource for finding fiction authors, titles, and series for all ages.
- **Twayne's Author Series** offers in-depth introductions to the lives and works of writers. *

Magazines and Newspapers :

- **Academic OneFile** has journals and reference sources, many of which are peer-reviewed and full-text covering the sciences, technology, social sciences, the arts, theology, literature, and more. *
- **Newsstand** provides full-text articles from domestic and international newspapers including 20+ NYS newspapers. *
- **General OneFile** is a general periodical database containing periodicals, newspapers, reference books, and multimedia sources. *
- **National Newspaper Index** includes only citations and abstracts for the NY Times, Wall St. Journal, Christian Science Monitor, LA Times, USA Today, and Washington Post from 1977 to present. *
- **Omnifile Select** has only full-text articles from 2,700+ publications in the areas of the arts, business, education, humanities, law, science and more.**

Resources for Children & Teachers:

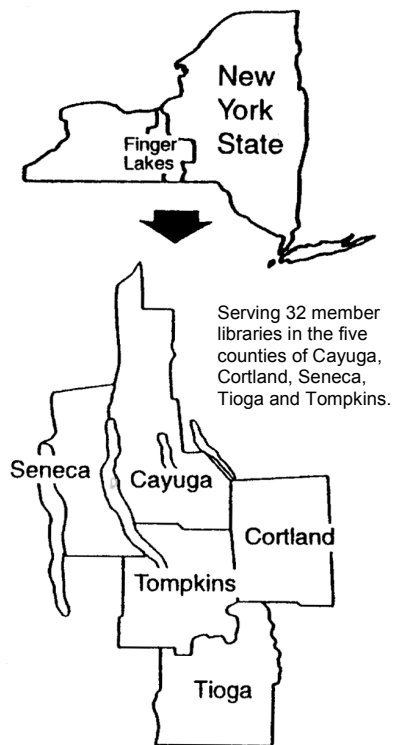
