

Updating Internet Explorer Privacy Settings for Public Computers

1. If you have Faronics Console
 - a. Select the computer(s) in Faronics Console
 - b. Click the Reboot Thawed icon
 - c. Log into Exec after reboot
2. If you do not have Faronics Console
 - a. Log in as Exec on the Public computer
 - b. Follow your instructions to set Deep Freeze to Boot Thawed
 - c. Reboot the computer
 - d. Log into Exec after reboot
3. Open "Disable Policies.pdf" on the desktop
4. Follow the instructions to disable polices on the Public userid
5. Log out of Exec
6. Log in as Public
7. Open Internet Explorer
8. Click on the Tools icon
9. Click on "Internet options"
10. In the Browser history section click the "Delete..." button
11. On the Delete Browsing History Window
 - a. Uncheck "Preserve Favorites website data"
 - b. Check all the other boxes
12. Click the "Delete" button
13. Click the "OK" button on the Internet Options window
14. Close Internet Explorer
15. Log out of Public
16. Log into Exec
17. Open the "Public Profile.msc" file from the desktop
18. Double-click "Administrative Templates" in the left pane of the Public Profile window to expand
19. Double-click "Windows Components" in the left pane of the Public Profile window to expand
20. Double-click "Internet Explorer" in the left pane of the Public Profile window to expand
21. Double-click "Delete Browsing History" in the right pane of the Public Profile window to expand
22. Double-click "Allow deleting browsing history on exit" in the right pane of the Public Profile window
23. Click the "Enable" option of the "Allow deleting browsing history on exit" window
24. Click "OK"
25. Scroll to the top of the left pane of the Public Profile window
26. Right-click "Local Computer\Public Policy"
27. Click on "Properties" from the drop-down menu



28. Uncheck the “Disable User Configuration settings” box
29. Click the “OK” button
30. Close the Public Profile.msc window
31. Click “YES” to save the changes
32. If you have Faronics Console
 - a. Select the computer(s) in Faronics Console
 - b. Click the Reboot Frozen icon
 - c. Log into Public after reboot, computer is ready for use
33. If you do not have Faronics Console
 - a. Follow your instructions to set Deep Freeze to Boot Frozen
 - b. Reboot the computer
