Arts:

- **Art Museum Image Gallery** (EBSCO) contains thousands of high quality artwork from diverse cultures created from 3000B.C. to modern day.**

Business:

- **Business Insights : Essentials** (GALE) has detailed company and industry news and information.*

Careers & Testing

- **Learning Express Library** offers academic & civil service test prep along with career development resources for students & adults.

Do-It-Yourself Resources

- **Auto Repair Reference Center** (EBSCO) has information on 30,000+ vehicles from 1945 to the present with detailed photographs, diagrams, and more.
- **Home Improvement Reference Center** (EBSCO) details popular projects for your home and garden with full-text reference books, images, and videos.

Encyclopedias/General Reference:

- **Grolier Online** includes the online encyclopedias *Encyclopedia Americana*, *Grolier Multimedia*, and *New Book of Knowledge and the resources New Book of Popular Science, Lands and People, America the Beautiful, Amazing Animals of the World, and La Nueva Enciclopedia Cumbre*.*

Genealogy:

- **HeritageQuest** (ProQuest) has one of the largest collections of genealogy material in the USA.

Health:

- **Health Reference Center Academic** (GALE) includes over 2,800 health and medical journals, and magazines, many of which are full text.*

Language Instruction:

- **Mango Languages** teaches practical conversational skills for 50+ languages and offers 16 ESL courses.

Literature:

- **Literary Reference Center** (EBSCO) features plot summaries, author biographies, and critical analyses of literary works with links to classic novels, short stories, poems, and images of literary figures.**
- **Novelist** (EBSCO) is a reader's advisory resource for finding fiction authors, titles, and series for all ages.

Magazines and Newspapers:

- **Academic OneFile** (GALE) has journals and reference sources, many of which are peer-reviewed and full-text covering the natural sciences, technology, social sciences, the arts, theology, and literature.*
- **Gannett Newsstand** (ProQuest) has full-text articles from 85 Gannett newspapers from across the country including Gannett newspapers in Binghamton, Elmira, Ithaca, and Rochester.*
- **General OneFile** (GALE) is a general-interest resource containing periodicals, newspapers, reference books, and multimedia sources.*
- **National Newspaper Index** (GALE) includes only citations and abstracts for the *NY Times*, *Wall St. Journal*, *Christian Science Monitor*, *LA Times*, *USA Today*, and *Washington Post* from 1977 to present.*
- **Newsstand** (GALE) provides full-text articles from domestic and international newspapers including 20+ NYS newspapers.*
- **OmniFile Select** (EBSCO) has full-text articles from 2,700+ publications in the areas of the arts, business, education, humanities, law, science, and library and information sciences.**

- **Learning Express Library** offers academic test preparation and basic skill building resources for students of all ages.

- **TumbleBooks** includes animated talking picture books, read-alongs, games and puzzles.

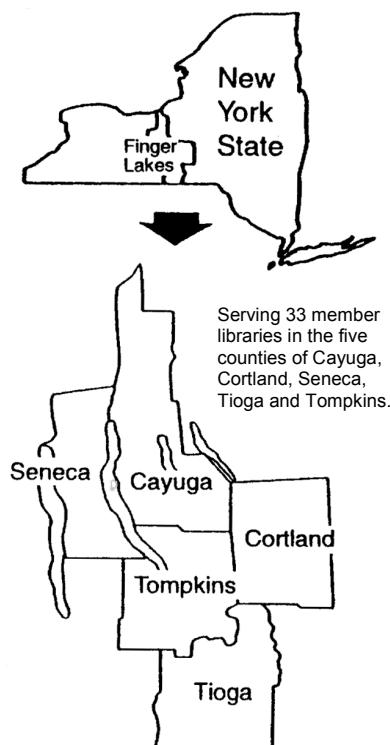
Science:
