## Introduction to the Counselor-In-Training (C.I.T.) Program

The FFL provides a unique opportunity for **girls entering 6<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade for the 2017-2018 school year** to build leadership skills as Counselors-in-Training (C.I.T.) for our Geek Girl Camp. As CITs, girls provide important support and guidance, and act as role models for our younger campers. For girls who have aged out of the camp, this is an opportunity to stay connected to the Geek Girl community and engage with the program in a more influential way.

### Important Dates:

- **April 10<sup>th</sup>:** CIT Applications open
- **May 31<sup>st</sup>:** CIT Applications close
- **June 5-9<sup>th</sup>:** CIT Interviews will take place (A limited number of CITs will be selected)
- **June 27<sup>th</sup> from 5-6 PM:** Mandatory CIT orientation meeting
- **July 11<sup>th</sup> from 5-7 PM:** Mandatory CIT training meeting
- **July 17<sup>th</sup>- July 21<sup>st</sup>, 9:30 AM-3:30 PM:** Geek Girl Camp

### Eligibility:

- Must be entering 6<sup>th</sup> grade (**ages 11-12**) through high school (max age 18) during 2017-2018 school year
- Must be energetic, motivated and like to work with younger kids
- Must be committed to take on responsibility and be a role model
- Must be committed to attend camp and trainings during the times specified above
- Requires demonstrated maturity, energy, enthusiasm and communication skills

### Responsibilities:

- Set a good example by being a positive role model
- Plan and assist with "transition" and "downtime" activities, engaging the campers during drop-off and pick-up times
- Assist Camp Counselors with hands-on activities and experiments
- Help prep, set up and clean up daily activities
- Associate with campers - NOT other Counselors in Training- during activities
- Abide by all rules, policies and procedures
- Treat all campers equally- there will be no favoritism
- Be cooperative with the head counselors, peers, speakers, campers & library staff
- Be enthusiastic and have a positive attitude

## 2017 COUNSELOR-IN-TRAINING CODE OF CONDUCT AGREEMENT

In order for the CIT Camp Program to be fun and safe, there needs to be rules. These rules will be strictly enforced:

- Set a good example by being a positive role model. –Use appropriate language, remember campers' eyes and ears are always on you.
- Show respect for all – Treat all campers equally, there will be no favoritism. You are an important support role in your group that helps both the counselors and campers. It is important to work together!
- Do not judge others or tease other campers or CITs – **We have a zero tolerance for bullying.**
- Associate with campers NOT other Counselors in Training during activities.
- Be cooperative, helpful, and alert – Pay attention to when counselors or campers need help. You will assist with daily activities and help to ensure the camp runs smoothly.
- Keep hands to yourself – You need to set a good example, so we advise you stay away from any contact both in silliness and maliciousness.
- Be enthusiastic and have a positive attitude – Smile! Try to stay positive when dealing with all scenarios.
- Cell phone use is not permitted during camp.

The rules of the CIT program are to ensure that everyone has a good time and remains safe. If a camper has trouble following the above rules, he/she will be referred immediately to a librarian. We reserve the right to suspend a CIT at any time due to disrespectful behavior (no refunds will be given).
