HHRT IS MINECRAFT RNYWRY?

- A game of creativity and (sometimes) survival within an infinite world of discovery
- World is made up of blocks which can be destroyed, placed, and crafted into new items
- Open-ended goals



<u>Survi</u>val us creative

- Survival Mode:
 - Start with nothing.
 - Monsters at night and in caves.
 - Death by any number of causes possible likely!
- Creative Mode:
 - Infinite resources of any block/item
 - Monsters aren't hostile
 - Cannot die

WHY LIBRARIES?

- Great for reaching the tween/teen crowd
- Encourages creativity and cooperation between players
- Teaches social skills
- Teaches technology skills
- Gets kids in the library
- Makes the library a 'cool' place
- Gets kids reading!



THE MANY WAYS TO PLAY

- Minecraft is available as:
 - Console game (XBOX, PLAYSTATION)
 - Desktop/Laptop download
 - Mobile Device app
 - Or grab some Legos and pretend...








PC VERSION

- Minecraft program gets downloaded onto PC
- Users log in when program opens
 - Like an email
 account...once a user
 has an account, they
 can log into it
 anywhere
 - Accounts cost \$26.95
 - Minecraft.net or as gift cards



TABLET VERSION

- Minecraft "Pocket Edition"
- Buy the app (\$2.99)
- App serves as the account
 - No logging in
 - Works ONLY on that device
- Pocket Edition not as updated as PC Version



MULTIPLRYER

- Computer:
 - Servers allow players to connect to one another through the internet
 - Servers can be as simple as opening a game to LAN or as complex as purchasing a 3rd party server
- Tablets:
 - Tablets connect with one another via WIFI
 - * * * PCs AND TABLETS CANNOT CONNECT TO ONE ANOTHER! * * *

FREE COMPLITER 5ERVER

- Open game to LAN
 - That computer must always have the game running for the server to run
 - Limited settings and control
- Run Minecraft Server program off computer
 - Downloadable file from Minecraft
 - Server program can run in background
 - Firewall and security issues

PRID COMPLITER SERVERS


- Purchase 3rd party server (i.e. Fluctis.com)
 - Easy set up with assistance
 - Total control
 - Keeps library computers open and free
- Minecraft Realms
 - Official Minecraft multiplayer service
 - Only 10 players at a time
 - -\$13/month

MINECRAFT AT GRO

- Started as Teen Thing program, then Teen Night, then Summer Reading, then...
- Installed on all (10) public computers
- Purchased 10 accounts for public use
- Installed on 17 iPads
 - There is an iTunes work-around so you don't have to buy it for every single iPad!

DUR SERVER

- Purchased 512 mb server from Fluctis.com
 - Good for up to 14 players
 - \$40 annually (sale price of \$26 for 1st year)
 - Comes with 'Minecraft Panel' for management
 - Players log in using internet address



RDD-DN5

- CoreProtect
 - Records complete history of actions
 - Can 'roll back' any actions
- Lockette
 - Allows players to 'lock' chests to keep items safe
- NoSwear
 - Language filter/ban
- ScreenText
 - Welcome title





PROGRAMS

- Teen Thing
 - Introduced Minecraft in the library
 - Focused on teaching how to play
- Teen Night
 - Available on computers and iPads during movie nights
 - Some kids too engrossed even to eat the pizza and chips! *GASP*

- Summer Reading
 - Tuesday Morning Parties
 - GameTruck night
 - Open use of computers exclusively for Minecraft

- International Game
 Day @ Your Library
 - Massive Hunger Games tournament
 - GRO represented in finals in 2015!
- Sean Faye Wolfe author visits

YOUTH INVOLVEMENT

- Minecraft Club
 - Like a TAB for Minecraft
 - Maintain server as moderators
 - Set rules and policies for gameplay
 - Decide on (or create!)add-ons
 - Design and run programs

- In-Game
 - Build structures they want
 - Create economy and government
 - Rules enforcement



<u>MINECRAFT LINGO</u>

- Creeper- One of the monsters of Minecraft. Sneaks up on players and explodes
- Mob- Minecraft generated being, either friendly or not
- Noob/newbie- a new player
- PVP- Player vs Player
- Griefer- A player who kills others and steals or destroys their stuff
- Spawn- Where a player first appears, or starts after dying

- Skin- What a player looks like
- Crafting- using game blocks to create something new
- Diamonds- one of the most valuable resources in Minecraft
- Nether- An alternate, hellish dimension in Minecraft
- Ender Dragon- the end boss of Minecraft (though the game never really ends...)

HOW TO PLRY

ESC: access menu (pauses game) OR exit inventory

Q: throw item/switch hand

W: forward S: backward A: left D: right

SHIFT: crouch (good for ledges)

F2: screenshot

F3: stats & info

E: access inventory

F5: change view

T: chat

LEFT CLICK: act on an object (dig, attack, etc.)

RIGHT CLICK: use an object (door, chest, crafting table, etc.)




SPACE: jump

GET ON THE SERVER

- 1)Log in
 - We have Minecraft accounts for you to use!
- 2) Click 'Multiplayer'
- 3) Click 'Add Server'
- 4) Enter a server name (can be anything) and the server address: grotonpubliclibrary.fluctis.com:26141
- 5) Click 'Done'
- 6) Select the server from the list
- 7) Click 'Join Server'
