Partnerships, Outreach, & School Visits

- ★ Visiting the schools reaches the most kids
 - ★ School visit handout
 - ★ Maintain a relationship with the school all year
- ★ Outreach to underserved areas and communities
 - ★ Pop up libraries, little free libraries, traveling storytimes, table at fairs
 - ★ Food pantries, childcare, eldercare, shelters, businesses, community centers
 - ★ Sign up for library cards, demonstrate eContent, giveaways
- ★ Partnerships bring in expertise, take the library into the community, allow for larger scope projects

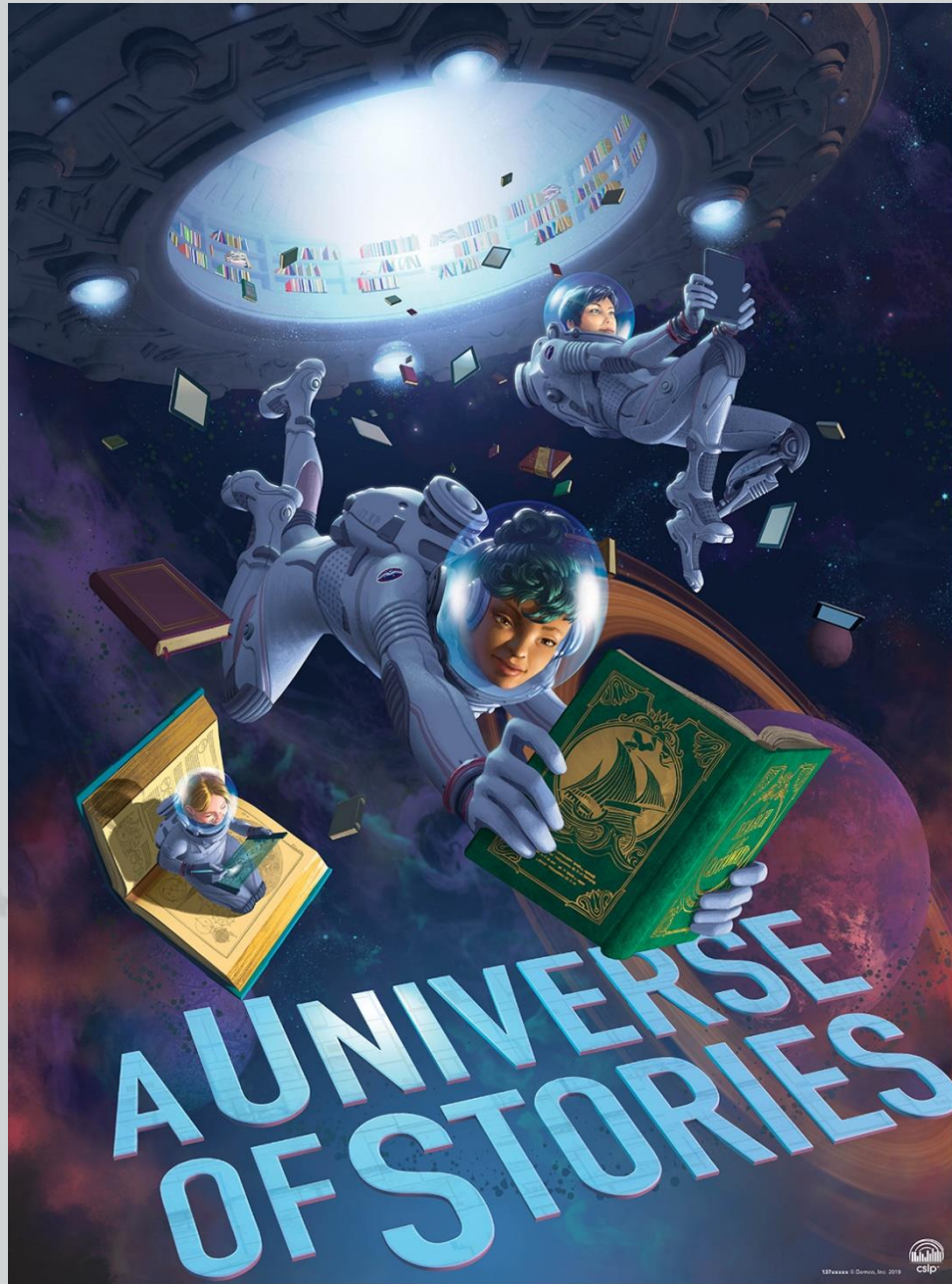
