We are able to register eligible patrons for the TBBL program and we have devices available. Contact our Outreach department to learn more.



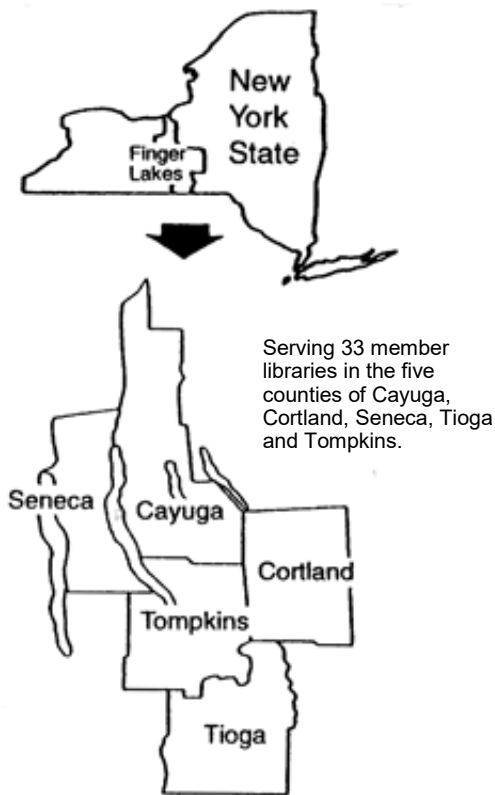
