

Polaris Vega Proposal

Released in the summer of 2021, this new interface for our library catalog, Polaris, was demonstrated to our member libraries at our last quarterly FALCONS meeting. Vega is an additional service of Polaris and has an annual subscription cost.

There are two main sections of Vega – a catalog component and a patron engagement component. For the catalog portion, it will bring a more modernized look to our catalog. Vega is designed specifically to address many of the unsolved challenges inherent in current public library solutions. Features include:

- **Modern Discovery** Modern web search tools that match how users find and explore content on popular platforms.
- **Patron Self-Service** Personalized discovery experience with an always-present bookshelf that is easy to find and visually appealing. Patrons can save individual titles or searches, create custom lists, and update their preferences.
- Work Roll-Ups Eliminates endless scrolling by combining formats and editions into a single search result with one smart "hold" or "check-out" button, simplifying workflows and offering at-a-glance availability.
- Integrated e-Content Place holds, check out items, and get started with your e-book or eaudiobook all through Vega Discover.
- **Showcases** Provide access to related materials, people, and topics in a visual interface that encourages people to explore and uncover further areas of interest.
- Accessibility Responsive user interface works across devices, adheres to latest accessibility standards, and supports multiple languages.
- **Cloud-based Design** Built as software-as-a-service, on a new multi-tenant platform.

For patron engagement, Vega offers multiple ways for our libraries to engage with patrons, staff, donors and community members. These include:

- Interact Sends appealing and personalized notifications through preferred communication channels.
- **Promote** Keeps patrons and community members well informed through targeted and relevant communications. Designed specifically for library marketing needs, libraries can run campaigns, build landing pages, design websites and fundraise.
- **Program** Libraries can easily manage library events through registration forms, landing web pages, automated event flyers, and attendee communications. You can also auto-create event brochures, and have embedded calendars to ensure all patrons find the events that are right for them.
- Analyze Measure library's impact and outcomes through data and guided analysis.

Feedback from our member libraries has been extremely positive. However, our members are worried about increased Polaris fees. Our negotiations with Polaris are included in a separate attached document. For Vega costs, FLLS would be using money from our technology budget line to help offset the costs to our member libraries. We are currently considering a split of 75/25, with FLLS covering 75% of the annual fee for Vega.

Hi Rex, see attached. I've reduced your Yr 3 of 3 to 2%, with 3.5% static increase over the next 5 yrs (after this last year of your contract). That saves the library an additional \$6,961.50 over the term of your contract. I'm hopeful this will be incentive to move forward, I've done my absolute best to get this as reduced as possible!

Hi Rex,

Our last offer did provide a 30% discount on Vega Discover - that said, I went back to my Director, to see what I could - and I have the following approved:

Vega Discount at 30% Annual increase reduced to 2% in first year of the new contract 3.5% annual increases from year 2-5

I've tried my absolute best to make this feasible for FLLS, and I know that Vega will be an incredible addition for your staff and patrons! We have such positive response from our libraries currently using it. With regards to PowerPac, it is in the bundle so it won't go away, allowing for patrons to continue using if they wish (at least in the short term).

Can you let me know if this would work so that I can prepare the required paperwork.

Beatrice,

We are inching closer to a final decision on Vega. I'm feeling positive about it but as I've commented about before, the cost is a hurdle for our small libraries. I think we can get over that if our annual costs can be frozen for a fixed period of time. My Director has suggested we renegotiate our annual maintenance contract maybe for 5 years to a zero increase over the 2022 cost. The concern is that we can't just jack up our fee to the libraries to cover the entire cost of Vega immediately but could get there with gradual annual increases starting in 2023 to cover the cost of Vega. Do you think this is something we can get done? I also have a question about PowerPAC. Since at some point we won't be using or need PowerPAC once we've been on Vega for a while. Will that be removed from our annual maintenance? Although I see that it is no longer listed separately but is possibly included in the Core Software.
