

Public Library Construction Aid Grants: 2022 – 2023 Cycle

Cortland – Parapet section replacement; elevator expansion/reconfiguration; Main Reading Room reconfiguration (create a dedicated Teen Room, Community Meeting Room and have a dedicated Makerspace Area); HVAC installation for Main Reading Room; exterior sign installation. Total cost of the project is **\$802,334**. Funding requested is **\$601,705**.

Seneca Falls – Installation of one ADA compliant restroom; two secondary restrooms with a new water line to mediate water pressure issues; installation of an indoor library book drop with outdoor slot location. Total cost of project is **\$303,751**. Funding requested is **\$275,826**.

Waterloo – Removing bushes in the front of the library; digging a drainage drywell 300 feet from the building; properly routing three downspouts from the front of the building into the drywell; rerouting of sump pump; accessing the grade and replacing it with proper stone; light pole lighting will be changed to solar lighting; double sided sign lighting will be replaced with LED lighting. Total cost of the project is **\$7,795**. Funding requested is **\$5,800**.

Finger Lakes Library System has a total of **\$905,464** in Construction Aid funding to award in the 2022 – 2023 grant cycle. We will be able to fund all of the above projects at the amount requested. The total amount of funding given will be **\$883,331**. This leaves **\$22,133** in leftover funding to be shared with other systems in New York State that need additional funding to cover their projects.
