



Ballot Funding

In 2021, funding from ballot funding started to return to pre-pandemic rates. After halting votes in 2020 due to the pandemics, more libraries felt comfortable asking for increases in 2021. 13 of our libraries went for increases in 2021 and all libraries asking for increases were successful.

The pandemic continues to highlight the importance of libraries having access to stable and secure funding through ballot votes and not having to solely rely on State, County or Village/Town/City funding. 
