Narrative: FLLS is partnering with the Sciencenter on an IMLS grant application. Deliverables include creating STEM kits for libraries and offer training around the kits so library staff can confidently offer programming on several STEM topics. The kits would align with the Collaborative Summer Library Program themes from 2025-2027. We are moving ahead with a marketing project tentatively called FLX Library Road Trip 2024. I held an info session for member libraries to outline the project. Summer Reading 2024 is already on the mind. Once again FLLS will be working with other systems around the state to offer two virtual programming workshops for our members to get ideas. I've also started planning for the FLLS Summer Reading Planning meeting. We're moving the meeting to April (was in March).
