Lower this year due to a mild winter - very little snow removal required and likely lower heating costs.

I believe some supplies reported here in previous years were in the wrong category so I moved them down to miscellaneous.

Last year we discovered an error Trustees made years ago with the retirement accounts. This year we worked with an attorney to fix the problem. Legal fees are reflected here. This year we significantly increased our program presenters and speakers through getting additional grants. Those costs are also reflected here. I believe that previously we had not broken those out correctly and they were reported in 12.23 in previous years.

Some of these expenses (outreach supplies, program supplies) were reported incorrectly in 12.18 in previous years, that is why there is a difference here.
